



APPRAISER II City of Green Bay

The City of Green Bay Assessor's Office seeks an Appraiser II to appraise real estate and personal property for assessment purposes. This position requires considerable knowledge of the principles and practices of real estate appraisal and local, social, and economic factors affecting real estate property values. This position also requires considerable knowledge of mathematical and statistical tools used in real property appraisal and knowledge of the law as it pertains to the assessment of real property.

Requirements include an Associate's Degree in Accounting, Business Administration, Real Estate, or a directly related field (Bachelor's Degree desired); four years full-time experience in property assessment and three years in commercial or manufacturing property appraisal; certification at an Assessor II level in accordance with the State of Wisconsin Assessor Certification requirements (or ability to obtain within one year of hire); completion of IAAO Course 102 in the appraisal of income properties preferred; experience with revaluations preferred; and a valid driver's license and good driving record.
